## ORDINANCE NO. 02-2013

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF BERKS TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS, THE PENNSYLVANIA BOARD OF PROBATION AND PAROLE AND THE COUNTY OF BERKS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING PROGRAMMING AND FULL CUSTODY RESIDENTIAL SERVICES TO TECHNICAL PAROLE VIOLATORS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, the Act of July 5, 2012, P.L. 1050, No. 122, authorizes the transport and recommitment to a state correctional institution or contracted county institution of a parolee under the jurisdiction of the Board, if the offender commits a technical violation of the terms and conditions of his or her parole, and if that violation is found to be enumerated within five enumerated conditions; and

WHEREAS, the County operates a full custody correctional center; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to partner with the Department and the Board in implementing programs as described above for offenders under the jurisdiction of the Commonwealth.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Berks, Pennsylvania as follows:

- 1. The Title and Background of this Ordinance set forth above are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. The Board of Commissioners of the County of Berks ("Commissioners") hereby approve entering into the Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporate herein as Attached A (and which shall be filed with the minutes of the meeting at which this Ordinance was enacted), with the intent and effect that the County of Berks ("County") shall be bound by the Agreement.
- 3. The Commissioners are hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the County: (i) to execute and deliver the Agreement; and (ii) to execute and deliver such additional instruments, and to take such further actions, as may be necessary or appropriate to carry forth the Agreement and the transactions to be effected under the Agreement, including acceptance of payment as may be due the County to administer the terms of the Agreement.
- 4. All actions of any officer, agent or other representative of the Commonwealth and County heretofore taken in the pursuit of the establishment of the Intergovernmental Agreement is hereby ratified and approved in all respects.

- 5. The Commissioners are hereby authorized to take such other action as may be necessary or appropriate to carry out the purposes of this Ordinance and of the Agreement.
- 6. Nothing contained in this Ordinance shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding in any court, or any rights acquired or liability incurred, or any cause of action existing prior to the enactment of this Ordinance.
- 7. This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by applicable law.
